Abstract / Discussion (E-1, E-3, E-4):

In the Statement of Account data dictionary, the data element *Invoice Date* is sender's option (SO). In the EDI Statement of Account transaction set, the *Invoice Date* is mapped to an ANSI mandatory field (ADJ05) because the detail level ANSI X12 ADJ segment in which this field is mapped contains two date fields and both are ANSI mandatory. The explanatory wording for ADJ05 reads as follows: "*Invoice Date - For GISB, this element is Sender's Option. Send ???????*" if not applicable." However, ADJ05 is a "date" field and "???????" is not a valid date, so this is incorrect and cannot be implemented.

The Technical Subcommittee recommends maintaining the current mapping of the *Invoice Date* data element to the ANSI mandatory field ADJ05. However, the explanatory verbage would be modified to *"Invoice Date - For GISB, this element is Sender's Option. Repeat the data element Due Date if not applicable."*
